- (3) Three dollars and fifty six cents (3.56) for each 1,000 gallons or portion thereof for the next 20,000 gallons, in excess of 20,000 gallons used during that month.
- (4) Four dollars and nineteen cents (4.19) for each 1,000 gallons or portion thereof over 40,000 gallons used in that month.

PAYMENT OF UTILITY BILLS:

- All utility bills are mailed approximately the first day of each month.
- Any utility bill not paid on or before the **15th** of the month will be subject to a late charge of **\$10.00**.
- Any utility bill not paid on or before the **25th** of the month shall subject that utility customer user to an additional late charge of **\$40.00** for nonpayment and liable to have the water service disconnected **without notice** beginning the **26th** of the month (unless the 26th falls on a weekend or holiday — disconnection would then take place on the next business day).
- Regardless of whether water has been disconnected, customers shall pay all accumulated late charges.
- If water reconnection is requested after 4:00 p.m. on weekdays or on a weekend, there will be an additional after hours charge of **\$60.00**.

If for some reason you do not get your utility bill, it is still your responsibility to pay you, utility bill. Please call or come by Town Center to find out the amount of your bill!

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REFUSE COLLECTION GUIDELINES FOR THE TOWN OF DUNDEE

PLACE ALL WASTE AT THE CURB BY 7AM ON SERVICE DAY TO INSURE TIMELY PICKUP.

YOUR GARBAGE PICKUP WILL BE SERVICED ON TUESDAY AND FRIDAY STARTING JULY 2ND 2004.

YOUR VEGETATION WILL BE SERVICED ON WEDNESDAYS.

ALL GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, AND GARBAGE MUST BE CONTAINERIZED IN GARBAGE CANS OR BAGS NOT TO EXCEED 33 GALLONS OR 50 POUNDS.

LIMBS MUST BE BUNDLED AND CANNOT EXCEED 5 INCHES IN DIAMETER OR 5 FEET IN LENGTH.

APPLIANCES WILL BE PICKED UP CURBSIDE AT NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE. PLEASE CALL TOWN HALL OR FLORIDA REFUSE OFFICE FOR PICKUP.

HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS, CHEMICALS, BATTERIES, AND AUTO PARTS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP, PAINT CANS IF PAINT IS DRY, AND CAR TIRES AND BATTERIES ARE THE EXCEPTION IF PLACED CURBSIDE.

NOW, THEREFORE, SE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That chapter 54, Article III, Division 2, section 54-129, of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee, Florida, is hereby amended as follows.

ARTICLE III SEWER

DIVISION 2. RATES

Sec. 54-129. Sewer user rates.

The following schedule of monthly rates for sewer customers on the town's sewer system is hereby established and approved. A flat monthly rate shall be charged to all single family residential units that are sewed by a single water meter (i.e., where one water meter serves one residential unit). All master metered multi-family residential, commercial, and industrial customers shall pay a monthly sewer rate based upon the size of the water meter and the amount of water used per month.

(1) For all customers within the town limits:

- a. The following monthly flat charge for sewer use is hereby established for single-family residential units: Effective March 1, 2006 \$37.50. Effective June 1, 2006 \$50.00.
- b. The following monthly base charge is hereby established for all multi-family, commercial and industrial users:

- c. The following monthly sewer usage charge is hereby established for all master metered multifamily, commercial, and industrial customers, based upon the amount of water used during any one month.

(1) \$2.02 for each 1,000 gallons of water used.

(2) For all customers outside the town limits:

- a. The following monthly flat charge for sewer use is hereby established for all single-family residential units: Effective March 1, 2006 \$46.88. Effective June 1, 2006 \$63.00.
- b. The following monthly base charge is hereby established for all multifamily commercial and industrial users:

- c. The following monthly sewer Usage charge is hereby established for all master metered multifamily, commercial, and industrial customers, based upon the amount of water used during any one month.

(1) \$2.52 for each 1,000 gallons of water used.

(3) Commencing on October 1, 2006 and effective on the 1st of October each year thereafter, all Town wastewater rates, fees and charges then in effect shall be automatically increased, without hearing, two and one-half percent (2 %%). A revised Table setting forth rates as of each October - I shall be on file in the Town clerk's office

2. All other provisions of Chapter 54 not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

3. If any provision or portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption after a second and final reading.

6. It is the intention of the Town Council that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Town; and that sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "chapter", "section", "article", or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions; and regardless of whether such inclusion in the Code is accomplished, sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the correction of typographical and/or scrivener's errors which do not affect the intent may be authorized by the Town Manager or his designee, without need of public hearing, by filing a corrected or recodified copy of same with the Town Clerk.

WATERING SCHEDULE:

WATERING IS ALLOWED ONLY 2 DAYS PER WEEK BY THE WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

- Residents with addresses ending in an even number or the letters A through M:
May water on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

- Residents with addresses ending in an odd number or the letters N through Z:
May water on Wednesdays and Sundays.

WATER BEFORE 10:00 A.M. OR AFTER 4:00 P.M.

No watering is allowed between 10 a.m. & 4 p.m. No watering is allowed on Mondays, Thursdays or Fridays. The rules do not restrict car washing or irrigation of non-lawn portions of the landscape, hand watering or the use of low-volume irrigation methods to any particular day of the week. Please use hoses with shut-off valves when washing vehicles.

ORDINANCE 04-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5441(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE, FLORIDA RELATING TO UTILITIES AND UTILITY SERVICE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

WHEREAS, the Town of Dundee has determined that it is necessary to revise and clarify the manner and procedures in which it renders bills for utility services including late charges and reconnection charges; and

WHEREAS, such revisions and clarifications are beneficial to the residents of the Town of Dundee and will promote the fiscal integrity of the Town's utility Services.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 54-71(c) of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee, Florida, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "(c) After February 28, 2004, all bills for utility service charges shall be mailed approximately the first of each month. Each bill shall be due and payable on or before the 15th of the month. A utility bill not paid on or before the 15th of the month shall subject that utility customer user to a late charge of \$10.00. Any utility bill not paid on or before the 25th of the month shall subject the user to an additional late charge of \$40.00 for nonpayment and liable to have the water service disconnected without notice beginning on the 26th of the month (unless the 26th falls on a weekend or holiday in which case such disconnection shall be made the following business day). Regardless of whether water has been disconnected, customers shall pay all accumulated late charges. In all cases where water has been disconnected for nonpayment of utility charges, reconnecting the water service to the premises for such user shall be made after payment of all accumulated charges. If such reconnection is requested to be made after 4:00pm on weekdays, on a weekend, or holidays, an additional charge shall be paid for such "after hours" reconnection of \$60.00. All payments for utility service, late charges, nonpayment fees, and reconnection charges shall be made at the Town Hall during normal business hours.

Section 2. All Ordinances In conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any provision or portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, Then all remaining provisions End portions Of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect,

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect at 12:01am on the day following its second and final reading in the manner provided by law.

PASSED on first reading at a meeting duly assembled and held on the 13' day of January 004.

READ, PASSED, AND FINALLY ADOPTED on second reading at a meeting of the Town Council duly assembled on the 9th day of March 2004.
